One year scholarship for senior attending a two or four year college, university of vocational school, pursuing a career in a mining related field or be from a mining family; at least a 2.5 GPA and service to the school or community are required.

Evansville Teachers "Ted Hitch" Scholarship

Applicant or Applicant's parents or guardians must have been a member of the Evansville Teacher's Credit Union for at least one year by the scholarship deadline of February 1. Applicants should have a minimum of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale at the end of the fall semester of the senior year. An essay is required and two letters of reference are required. Only one reference may be an employee of the applicant's school.

Charles R. Cronenwett Rotary Academic Scholarship

Male or female with at least a 3.5 GPA after 7 semesters enrolling in an accredited college, university or vocational school; must describe exemplary academic record and a high level of involvement in extra-curricular activities. The applicant must not be a member of a Vincennes Rotarian's family.

Persis McClure Hurst Memorial Scholarship

An annual scholarship created by Sarah H. Keller in memory of her mother; graduating senior of any Knox County High School planning to attend an Indiana college or university. Applicants must demonstrate interest in English or history and plan to pursue a major in English or history; 2 letters of recommendation (1 from a high school official and the other from someone unrelated to the applicant and who is not on the foundation board; statement of aspirations and educational goals (not to exceed two typewritten double spaced pages.

McKinley Avenue Presbyterian Church Student Scholarship

An annual scholarship created by the McKinley Avenue Presbyterian Church student scholarship fund committee; senior from Knox County demonstrating financial need, academic performance, school and extra-curricular activities and essay; statement of aspirations and educational goals (not to exceed two typewritten double spaced pages; completion of the Financial Assistance Questionnaire.

Velma & Herbert Pepmeier Scholarship

An annual scholarship created by Herbert Pepmeier; graduation senior affiliated with St. John's United Church of Christ in Vincennes or the Bethel Church in Freelandville; selection is based on applicant's success in overcoming difficult circumstances, a history of working hard to achieve aspirations and goals, and financial need; statement of perseverance (not to exceed 2 typewritten double spaced pages) describing the challenges faced in order to pursue past and or future aspirations and goals; 2 letters of recommendations from individual who are unrelated to the applicant who are not foundation board members that support the applicant's ability to overcome challenges and obstacles; completion of the Financial Assistance Questionnaire is required.
