

# Kindergarten Round-Up For 2017-18 School Year

Kindergarten Pre-Enrollment for North Knox Primary School for the 2017-18 school year will be:

**Parents are asked to call the school at 812-735-2547 to schedule an appointment for their child's registration.** Appointment times will be scheduled from 8:30 AM to 10:45 AM and 11:30 AM to 2:30 PM. Parents should plan approximately 30-45 minutes for the registration process.

Any student enrolling in kindergarten at North Knox Primary for the 2017-18 school year **must be 5 years of age on or before August 1, 2017. Children should accompany their parents to the registration.** Each incoming kindergarten student will participate in a screening process for school readiness and speech evaluation.

**Parents should bring a copy of the child's birth certificate and all immunization records.**

Immunizations need to be up to date by the first day of school. It is strongly recommended that your child have a medical examination prior to the first day of school. Physical forms will be provided. Immunization requirements are listed on the back side of this sheet.

School Entry Immunization Requirements**

3 Doses- Hepatitis B

5 Doses- DTaP/DTP/DT (Diphtheria, Tetanus & Pertussis)

Four doses are acceptable if 4<sup>th</sup> Dose was administered on or after the child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

4 Doses- Polio (Inactivated Polio) IPV

The fourth dose of polio vaccine **must** be administered on or after child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

This applies only to kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade for 2017-18.

2 Doses- MMR (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella)

2 Doses- Varicella (Chickenpox)

Physician documentation of chickenpox history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grade.

2 Doses- Hepatitis A

These immunization requirements are set by the Indiana State Department of Health. The Knox County Immunization Clinic is located at 305 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street in Vincennes (812-882-8700). They will bill insurance. Appointments can be set by calling 812-882-8700. Office hours are Monday-Friday 8 AM to 4 PM.

Immunizations need to be up-to-date by the first day of school. If the parent requests the school nurse to obtain the immunization record from the Knox County Immunization Clinic, the parent must call the school prior to the pre-enrollment date and provide the student's name and their birth date. This will allow the nurse appropriate time to access the records and produce a hard copy for the permanent school records.
